Sunday 28th June from 2:30 p.m. onwards: Visit to **Pollies Daylilies** and a video of Pollie as she tours visitors around her Garden followed by a shopping spree. There is a wide range of daylilies for sale at her place in Mount Pleasant Ln, Sway, Lymington, SO41 8LS.

Pollies Daylilies is a well-known daylily nursery situated in Sway, Lymington, within the beautiful New Forest National Park. Pollie and Terry Maasz have cultivated daylilies for 35 years, making them among the few remaining authorities on British-grown daylilies. They have received two silver-gilt medals at the Hampton Court Flower Festival for their displays and run one of the two largest nurseries in the country.

Their fondness for spiders and unusual forms (UFO) led to them being awarded a Plant Heritage National Collection.

After four decades of cultivating daylilies, Pollie and Terry mainly propagate only the hardiest varieties that thrive well in our climate. To date, they have registered ten daylilies. This demonstrates that their screening process is thorough, and the plants must withstand the challenges presented by our changeable climate.

The couple previously organized a successful AGMs and have also hosted the BHHS Hampshire Group for ten years. We aim to revitalize the group and wish to gather annually at Pollies Daylilies along with other gardens in the southeast. Members and their friends living in the home counties are invited to join.

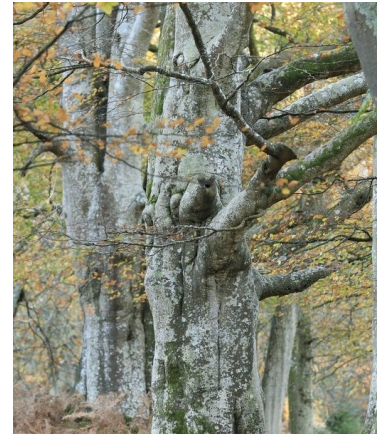

Where to Visit: *The New Forest*

Gardens: Check the opening times.

- Beaulieu Palace House Gardens, SO42 7ZN: A Victorian House with formal and informal garden with lovely walks around. There are several themes: Wilderness Garden, Victorian Flower and Kitchen Gardens, with some interesting topiaries.
- Blackwater Arboretum, SO42 7QB: A collection of beautiful trees from around the world with Douglas Fir and redwood slowly maturing. A place to enjoy the tranquil surroundings.
- Braxton Gardens, SO41 0TX : A series of gardens with herbs, vegetable and rose displays and a place to indulge in cream teas.
- Exbury Gardens and Steam Railway, SO45 1AZ: 200 acres of woodlands, meadows and walks along the Beaulieu River and view the magnificent collections of shrubs and herbaceous plants.
- Furzey Garden, SO43 7GL: Known for its dazzling spring display of plants collected by our 20th century plant hunters with plant sales and tea room.
- Spinners Garden, SO41 5QE: Please do not visit the garden individually as they only accept groups although they open for the NGS on specific dates.
- The Tall Trees Trail within the forest is a fantastic place to have a picnic. The New Forest Commons is excellent if you want to see the wild ponies. Please do not feed them.
